**FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS**

**Determination of Number of Voting Units Represented**

Mr. Flint: We have 693 voting units represented. That is based on some of the proxy's that we were provided. There were some ballots but not accompanied by proxy's and we weren't able to accept those. The owner either has to be here or they have to sign a proxy form designating the person who is casting the ballot.

**THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS**

**Election of a Chairman for the Purpose of Conducting the Landowners Meeting**

Mr. Flint was designated as Chairman for the purpose of conducting the Landowners' Meeting.

**FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS****Nominations for the Position of Supervisor**

Mr. Flint: You have three seats that are up for election. Any landowner that has provided the information upfront and then provided a ballot can nominate someone for those three seats. The only requirement for those three seats is that they are a resident of the State of Florida and citizen of the United States of America. They do not have to live within Reunion they just have to be a resident of Florida and US Citizen.

Mr. Chiste: I nominate Deborah Simmons and Jared Bouskila.

Ms. Simmons: I nominate John Chiste.

Mr. Greenstein: I nominate Thomas McKeon.

Mr. Baker: I nominate Carlton Grant.

Mr. Flint: We will close the nominations and those who have ballots you were provided a number of votes that you can cast based on the information that was provided. If you have 10 votes you can cast all 10. You have three seats that are open so you would write three of these individual's names on your ballot and then you can cast up to as many votes you have for each seat. You don't have to break up the 10 votes into three different seats.

**FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS****Casting of Ballots**

Mr. Flint: Once you do that we will collect those ballots from you, tally the votes, and then we will announce the results.

**SIXTH ORDER OF BUSINESS****Ballot Tabulation**

Mr. Flint: Mr. Chiste received 679 votes, Ms. Simmons received 373 votes, Mr. Bouskila received 385 votes, Mr. Grant received 320 votes and Mr. McKeon received 320 votes. Mr. Chiste and Mr. Bouskila will serve four-year terms and Ms. Simmons will serve a two-year term.
